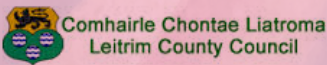

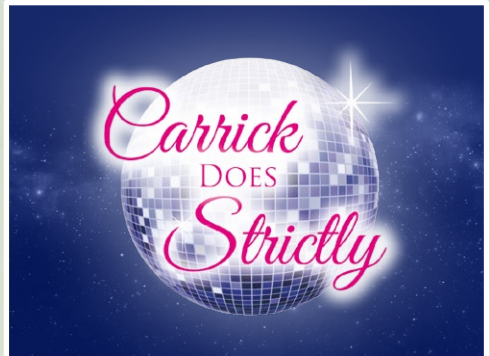

THE PROVISIONAL GOVERNMENT
OF THE
IRISH REPUBLIC
TO THE PEOPLE OF IRELAND.

IRISHMEN AND IRISHWOMEN: In the name of God and of the dead generations from which we receive our old traditions of national heroism, Ireland, through our common hereditary inheritance, is one and indivisible.

Having organised and trained her menhood through her sacred revolutionary organisation, the Irish Volunteers, Brothertown and the Irish Citizen Army, having patiently perfected her discipline, having resolutely waited for the right moment to reveal itself to the mass senses of the nation, and supported by her valiant children in America, and by gallant allies in Europe, but relying in the first on her own strength, she strikes in full confidence of victory.

We declare the right of the people of Ireland to the ownership of Ireland, and to the unfettered control of Irish destinies, to be sovereign and indefeasible. The long usurpation of this right by a foreign people and government has not extinguished the right, nor can it ever be extinguished except by the destruction of the Irish people. In every generation the Irish people have asserted their rights to national freedom and sovereignty: six times during the past three hundred years they have sacrificed life and blood. According to this fundamental right again, we declare it to be the duty of the world, we hereby proclaim the Irish Republic, to be Sovereign, Independent, Free, and to defend our lives and the lives of our co-nationals in the name of its traditions, its welfare, and of its exultation among the nations.

The Irish Republic is entitled to, and hereby claims, the allegiance of every Irishman and Irishwoman. The Republic guarantees religious and civil liberty, equal rights and equal opportunities to all citizens, and declares its resolve to pursue the happiness and prosperity of the whole nation and of all its parts, cherishing all the children of the nation equally, and oblivious of the differences carefully fostered by an alien government, which have divided a minority from the majority of the people.

Until our arms have brought the despotic monarchy to the establishment of a permanent National Government, representative of the whole people of Ireland and elected by the suffrages of all her men and women, the Provisional Government, hereby constituted, will administer the civil and military affairs of the Republic in trust for the people.

We place the cause of the Irish Republic under the protection of the Most High God, Whose blessing we invoke upon our arms, and we pray that no one who knows the cause will doubt it to be lawful, honourable, or just. In this respect none but the Irish nation must, by its valour and discipline, and by the confidence of its children to sacrifice themselves for the common good, prove itself worthy of the august destiny to which it is called.
